Dear Shepard Preparatory High School Community:

Our school is committed to protecting student, teacher, and staff health. To protect our community and be in compliance with the Department of Education regulations Agra Environmental and Laboratory Services tested our school's drinking water for lead.

Results of our Testing

Following instructions given in technical guidance developed by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, we completed a limited plumbing profile for the Shepard Preparatory High School building to identify all drinking water and food preparation outlets. Of the samples taken, all tested below the lead action level established by the US Environmental Protection Agency for lead in drinking water (15 µg/l [ppb]).
